



## Dressing Room Policy

1. Adults must not change at the same time using the same facility as Children.
2. In the case of mixed gender teams, boys and girls will be given separate dressing rooms. If this is not possible, girls may be given exclusive use of the changing room and leave before the boys enter or vice-versa. This should be coordinated by the teachers/production team.
3. The teachers or director should not enter the dressing room while the cast members are changing. He or she should knock on the door before entering.
4. Mobile phones or cameras must not be used in the dressing rooms at any time. Age-restricted items (e.g. magazines) should also not be taken into the dressing rooms.
5. Smoking and consumption of alcoholic beverages should not occur in the dressing rooms before, during or after rehearsals/performances. Drugs or other banned substances should not be brought to premises at any time.
6. If Children are uncomfortable changing at the venue, no pressure will be placed on them to do so. In these cases, Children are encouraged to arrive at and leave the club in their costumes.

**N.B. Children include anyone under 18 years of age.**
